7th Grade Welcome to the Jungle Rollout

Our 7th Grade students entered the JUNGLE this morning during their first interdisciplinary Rollout of the year. The students were excited to be a part of a day full of engaging hands-on activities. In ELA, our students have been reading the novel, The Jungle Book. The students practiced dictionary skills before the reading (connotation, meaning, part of speech, guide words), and then after reading students chose one piece of writing from a choice board to connect to the text and share how the lesson learned was relevant. Some students chose to write a personal narrative to thank a person in their life who has made a positive impact like Baloo did for Mowgli. Some students chose to add on to the graphic novel and create their own pictures/dialogue for what happened once Mowgli went into the real world from the jungle. Some focused on how the Laws of the Jungle are alike/different from our laws. The students also made masks in class and wore them for the roll-out and during our share-out. In math classes, students had to survive a series of critical thinking questions in order to escape! Thank you to all the teachers and staff who made this rollout possible. It's an experience our students will never forget!


DCMS PTSO Hosts Successful Santa Shop for Students

DCMS Teachers Complete Apple Teacher Certification










Seventh Grade Basketall Team Defeats Undefeated Union County
